## **BURSARIES**

The Agricultural Service Board of Yellowhead County will provide 2 - \$500.00 bursaries to students residing in Yellowhead County enrolled in a post-secondary institution. Applications are required to be:

## Accepted or currently enrolled in an agriculture or environmental sciences related program at a post-secondary institution.

Bursaries must be used in the year awarded. In the case of the recipients not completing their studies in year of award, all or a portion of the bursary may have to be refunded. The amount will be determined at the discretion of the awarding committee.

Bursaries will be awarded on the basis of the following, in no particular order:

- a) Academic Achievement
- b) Agricultural Background
- c) Community participation

Successful individuals may apply year after year however priority will be given to individuals that have NOT received the award in the past. The Agricultural Service Board will be responsible for awarding bursaries and also selecting an alternate in case a successful applicant cannot attend.

Deadline for applications is August 31, 2020. Awards are contingent upon successful completion of Grade 12 and/ or registration in a post-secondary institute.
