



Farm Family Centennial Award

Yellowhead County Council acknowledges the contribution that agriculture provides to the economy, the community and the County. Council wishes to recognize families who continue to farm on the same location over the generations.

The selection of applicants will require that:

1. Land has been continuously owned and actively farmed or ranched by the applicant's family for a minimum of 100 years.
2. The applicant can provide evidence of ancestral ties between the applicant and the original founder of the farm, ranch or homestead.
3. The applicant can provide the date and location of the original homestead establishment verified by the Alberta Land Titles office- historic land title documents.
4. The original homestead land base needs to be approximately 160 acres.

The Agricultural Services Supervisor will be responsible for reviewing all applications ensuring all application requirements are met.

Deadline for applications is August 31st. Awards are contingent upon successful completion of the application form with supporting documentation as outlined in the application form.

Attach the following information when submitting your application:

- A copy of the original Land Title. Contact Land Titles Alberta (780) 427-4166 to obtain your historic land title documents. If the earliest documents are not available, you can contact the Provincial Archives of Alberta at (780) 427-1750.
- Any related documents to verify that you are a direct descendent of the original homesteader.
- **Application deadline is August 31st.** The award of a gate sign and certificate of recognition will be presented in the year following the application, with the first awards being in the year 2015.
