STATEMENT

Yellowhead County Council understands and supports the importance of pest control and shall take active measures to prevent, control, or destroy Clubroot of Brassicaceae in the municipality and, as such, shall carry out the requirements of the Agricultural Pest Act of Alberta and its supplemental regulations.

DEFINITIONS

Agricultural Pest Act - means the *Agricultural Pest Act*, RSA 2000 c A-8 as amended from time to time.

Council means the duly elected officials of Yellowhead County.

Agriculture Services Appeal Committee means the independent panel established by Yellowhead County to determine appeals of inspector notices, Yellowhead County notices, and debt recovery notices issued pursuant to the Weed Control Act.

GUIDELINES

1. Responsibilities

1.1. Council

1.1.1. Council shall appoint inspectors to enforce and monitor compliance with the Agricultural Pest Act.

1.1.2. Council shall establish an Agricultural Services Appeal Committee.

1.2. Management

1.2.1. Administration will ensure compliance with all current legislated requirements and municipal bylaws and policies.

1.3. Agricultural Service Board


1.3.1. The Agricultural Service Board will review the policy every four years for Council approval.
