BYLAW NO.14.22

BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND THE SPEED LIMIT BYLAW 18.21

WHEREAS, Bylaw 18.21 was passed establishing a Speed Limit Bylaw for Yellowhead County;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 2000 c M-26, and amendments thereto, authorize a Council to amend a bylaw.

AND WHEREAS the Traffic Safety Act, R.S.A., 2000 c T-6, and amendments thereto, gives the authority for a Council of a municipality to make bylaws for the provision of speed limits on highways and roads under their direction and control;

AND WHEREAS, Yellowhead County Council deems it necessary to amend bylaw 18.21;

THEREFORE, Yellowhead County Council, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:


1. That Bylaw No. 18.21, be and is hereby amended by replacing paragraph 2 with the following:
 - a. That the maximum speed for vehicles in a subdivision with two or more lots with a road system contained within the subdivision boundaries will be 50 kilometers per hour.
2. That bylaw 18.21 and amendments thereto shall, in all other respects, remain the same.
3. This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the third and final reading thereof.

READ a third time this 23rd day of August 2022.
