



BYLAW NO. 3.07

*BEING A BYLAW OF YELLOWHEAD COUNTY,
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,
FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING A DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY*

WHEREAS, Section 624 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 2000, Chapter M-26 as amended (“the Act”) requires that a Municipal Council establish a Development Authority by bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Yellowhead County, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) This Bylaw shall be cited as the “The Development Authority Bylaw”.
- 2) Definitions in this Bylaw include:
 - a) “Act” means the Municipal Government Act;
 - b) “Chief Administrative Officer” means the Chief Administrative Officer of the County and the person who is appointed as such by the County Council, or anyone who is the acting Chief Administrative Officer of the County;
 - c) “Council” means the Reeve and Councillors of Yellowhead County;
 - d) “Development Authority” means the person or persons established under Section 3 herein to perform the functions of a development authority under the Act;
 - e) “Regulations” means the Regulations passed pursuant to the Act.
- 3) The Development Authority of Yellowhead County is hereby established.
- 4) The Chief Administrative Officer for Yellowhead County will exercise the powers, duties and functions of the Development Authority as described in the Act and in the Land Use Bylaw of Yellowhead County and shall exercise any additional powers as are described in the regulations or this bylaw.
- 5) The Chief Administrative Officer may delegate the powers, duties and functions of the Development Authority to any other persons.
- 6) This Bylaw shall take effect immediately upon the date of final reading.
- 7) Bylaw No. 38.95 is repealed.


