

YELLOWHEAD COUNTY

BYLAW NO. 34.04

BEING A BYLAW OF YELLOWHEAD COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF MUNICIPAL ASSESSOR FOR YELLOWHEAD COUNTY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, R.S.A., 2000 and amendments thereto, a council may create a designated officer position to carry out certain powers, duties, and functions; and

WHEREAS, Council now wishes to create a designated officer position to carry out the powers, duties and functions of assessor under the Municipal Government Act as municipal assessor.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Yellowhead County, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:


1. This bylaw may be cited as the "Municipal Assessor Bylaw".
2. Words importing the masculine gender only, include the feminine gender whenever the context so requires and vice versa.
3. Words importing the singular shall include the plural or vice versa whenever the context so requires.
4. The position of municipal assessor is hereby created as a designated officer position for Yellowhead County.
5. The powers and duties of the municipal assessor shall be:
 - 5.1 to carry out all obligations imposed upon the municipal assessor pursuant to the Municipal Government Act and regulations thereunder;
 - 5.2 to carry out all duties delegated to the municipal assessor by bylaw or resolution of Council or by any other statute, regulation, or order of the Province of Alberta, either prior to or subsequent to the passage of this bylaw;
6. The municipal assessor shall be appointed by resolution of Council.
7. Any previous municipal assessor appointments are hereby rescinded.
8. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
