



BYLAW NO. 07.19

BEING A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR A PENALTY ON UNPAID PROPERTY TAXES

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, Being Chapter M-26, R.S.A., 2000, and amendments thereto, authorize a Council to adopt a bylaw to impose penalties on a tax that is imposed if the tax remains unpaid after the due date shown on the tax notice.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council for Yellowhead County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) That any taxes imposed and remaining unpaid after the due date shown on the tax notice shall be added to, by way of a penalty, an amount equal to six percent (6%) of the unpaid tax for the current year.
- 2) That in the event there are tax arrears remaining unpaid after December 31 in any year following the year a tax is imposed, there shall be added a further penalty, on the first day of January of the following year, an amount equal to six percent (6%) of the tax arrears.
- 3) That any penalty so imposed shall be added to and form part of the tax in respect to which it is imposed.
- 4) This bylaw comes into force at the beginning of the day that it is passed in accordance with Section 189 of the Municipal Government Act, Being Chapter M-26, R.S.A., 2000.
- 5) Bylaw 6.97 is hereby repealed.


