BYLAW NO.13.22

BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND THE MEETING PROCEDURES BYLAW 15.17

WHEREAS, Bylaw 15.17 was passed establishing a Meeting Procedures Bylaw for Yellowhead County;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A., 2000 c M-26, and amendments thereto, authorize a Council to amend a bylaw.

AND WHEREAS, Yellowhead County Council deems it necessary to amend bylaw 15.17;

THEREFORE, Yellowhead County Council, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Bylaw No. 15.17, be and is hereby amended by:
 - a. Deleting paragraphs 17.2, 17.3. and 28.1;
 - b. Renaming Section 28 to "Recording and Livestreaming of Meetings" and inserting the following additions under Section 28:
 - 28.2 Council and Committee Meetings may be recorded and livestreamed to the public with the exception of Closed Sessions.
 - 28.3 At the start of a meeting, the Chair notifies those present that the meeting is being livestreamed and a recording will be made available on the County's public website after the meeting is adjourned.
 - 28.3.1 That the recording of the meeting will be available for viewing on the county's website for 48 hours.
 - 28.4 The Chair may, at any time at their discretion and/or at the request of a councillor(s), direct the termination or interruption of a livestream.
 - 28.5 If there are technical difficulties while livestreaming, the Chair advises those present at the meeting that the livestream is not available.
 - 28.5.1 Notice of the technical difficulties will be provided on the county's website.
 - 28.6 The approved minutes of a meeting will form the official record of the meeting. Any audio, video, or other records of the meeting shall not be considered an official record.



2. That bylaw 15.17 and amendments thereto shall, in all other respects, remain the same.
3. This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the third and final reading thereof.

READ a second time this 10 day of May 2022.

READ a third time this 10 day of May 2022.
