



BYLAW NO.19.20

*BEING A BYLAW OF YELLOWHEAD COUNTY,
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,
FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING MORE THAN ONE VOTING STATION FOR A VOTING
SUBDIVISION.*

WHEREAS, the Local Authorities Election Act, RSA 2000, Chapter L-21 states that the ward (division) is considered to be one voting subdivision; AND

WHEREAS, the elected authority may provide that a returning officer may designate more than one voting station for each subdivision and the location of those voting stations for that election; AND

WHEREAS, the Council of Yellowhead County deems it desirable to authorize the returning officer to designate more than one voting station for each subdivision.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council for Yellowhead County, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1) That the returning officer has the authority to designate more than one voting station for each subdivision and the location of those voting stations for that election.
- 2) Bylaw No. 20.01 is hereby rescinded
- 3) That Bylaw 19.20 shall come into force and effect at the beginning of the day that it is passed in accordance with Section 189 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000.
