What is a NeighbourLink Grant?

The "NeighbourLink" Grant is an opportunity for geographic neighbours to meet each other in a social environment. The grant is a one-time opportunity to offset costs of hosting a gathering.

The grant can accommodate different types of communities; rural, hamlet or subdivision.

Rural: up to \$250 for maximum of 25 house-holds that are located within direct geographic proximity of each other.

Hamlet or Subdivision: up to \$250 for maximum of 25 households that are located within direct geographic proximity of each other. If your area is heavily populated making it difficult to limit households to 25, you are eligible to apply for 2 NeighbourLink grants.

What are some requirements of the "NeighbourLink" grant?

Be inclusive of all neighbours within the geographic area.

Funding cannot be used for alcohol or cannabis, permanent structures or other items that will benefit one household.

What do I do?

Funding is on a reimbursement basis. Fill out the form, get approved, pick up your planning guide and amenity kit, and submit your report and receipts after you hold your event! Simple as that!
